BVRC 30th Anniversary Worked All States Award Rules

- 1) The WAS (Worked All States) Award is available to all BVRC members who submit honest, bona fide log extract proof with contacts with each of the 50 states of the United States of America. <u>QSL card or LotW (Logbook of the World) confirmations are not required for this award.</u> (It will be totally up to the applicant, and their responsibility, if they choose to use QSLs or electronic submissions to LotW for ARRL credit.)
- Two-way communication must be established on amateur bands with each state. There is no minimum signal report required. Contacts may be made on any of the bands 160-, 80-, 40-, 30-, 20-, 17-, 15-, 12-, 10-, 6-, or 2-Meters (with the exception of 60 Meters).
- 3) Contacts may be made with any mode: SSB, CW, AM, FM, FT8, FT4, RTTY, Satellite, etc.
- 4) All stations contacted must be "land-based stations." Contacts with ships, anchored or otherwise (Maritime Mobile), and aircraft (Aeronautical Mobile), cannot be counted.
- 5) The District of Columbia may be counted for Maryland.
- 6) Contacts must be made from the same location, or from locations no two of which are more than 50 miles apart.
- 7) Any contact made during calendar year 2023 can be used for this award. Submitted contacts that were made outside calendar year 2023 will be discounted.
- 8) The applicant's log extract must show: the applicant's call sign, receiving station's call sign, band, mode, date and time, and sent and received signal reports.
- 9) False logs, if detected, may result in disqualification from receiving the award.
- 10) After inspection and approval of the log submission a handsome certificate in .pdf form, suitable for printing and/or framing, will be sent to the applicant via e-mail attachment.
- 11) SUBMISSIONS:
